

RESOLUTION No. 2017-9

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF NACHES, WASHINGTON,
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 TO THE
NACHES TRAIL PEDESTRIAN LIGHTING**

WHEREAS, the Town of Naches entered into the Naches Trail Pedestrian Lighting project contract with Knobel's Electric, Inc.; and,

WHEREAS, Knobel's Electric was asked to assist the Town of Naches by deleting the following items from its contract; #8 wire for Daktronics circuit type 1 junction box, with a corresponding labor credit, for a total of \$2,568.64; and,

WHEREAS, Knobel's has reasonably determined that additional work under the contract is required in the form of materials and equipment to install a new 100 amp pedestal meter/panel combination adjacent to the PP&L pole with transformer which will add \$4,503.53 to the price of the contract; and,

WHEREAS, between the credit and additional sums requested Knobel's seeks change order approval for payment of an additional \$1,934.89; and,


WHEREAS, conduit and conductor for the panel for the Naches' "Welcome Sign" will be installed at a future date under a separate change order;”

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NACHES, WASHINGTON, as follows:




