

**TOWN OF NACHES  
RESOLUTION NO. 2019-17**

**A RESOLUTION** of the Town of Naches, Washington, authorizing the Mayor to accept the Naches Trail Pedestrian Lighting Project as complete and allow for 100% payment, less retainage, to the contractor.

**WHEREAS**, the improvements generally called the “Naches Trail Pedestrian Lighting Project (aka) Phase 3” have been completed; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council, as part of its business on November 12, 2019, approved the final payment for the work done, less the retainage bond; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council retained the retainage for sixty days after completion of the project, as required under the contract; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council desires to accept the Naches Trail Pedestrian Lighting Project as complete; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council finds it is in the best interest of the Town of Naches and its residents to accept the Naches Trail Pedestrian Lighting project as complete and release the retained amount of payment as outlined in the contract;

**Now, therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF NACHES, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Town Council authorizes the Mayor of Naches to accept the Naches Trail Pedestrian Lighting Project as complete.
2. The amounts held in retainage pursuant to the contract shall be disbursed to the contractor upon the Town receiving all the releases.
3. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and signatures hereto.

**ADOPTED by the Town Council and approved by the Mayor at the regular meeting of the Town Council held on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2019.**




